Town of LaSalle Projects

Reaume Road and Bouffard Road Watermain Replacement

This past summer, the Public Works Department began a project to construct new watermains and a section of the LaSalle Trail.



The Town received a \$4,000,000 Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program grant to replace the watermain along Reaume Road from Malden Road to Milford Avenue, and on Bouffard Road from Malden Road to Matchett Road. The work involves replacing the existing 2,803 metres of watermain on Reaume Road and 1,416 meters

on Bouffard Road with new and wider local water pipes, reattaching the side street interconnections, and installing 22 new fire hydrants and 39 gate valves.

The project also includes the extension of the LaSalle Trail on the north side of Reaume Road from Matchett Road to Smith Crescent.

Second Fire Station Groundbreaking Ceremony

The Town of LaSalle held a groundbreaking ceremony Monday, October 30, at the site of the future second fire station, 2160 Front Road. The tender was awarded to Gulf Developments with a bid of \$9,000,000. It is expected that the second fire station will be open for use in early 2025.

“Building a second fire station shows our commitment to building a safer LaSalle. Community safety has been and always will be a top priority for both Council and administration,” said Mayor Crystal Meloche.

There are several factors that have led to the building of this new station. This includes growth within the Town in both the short to mid-term and long-term, and the National Fire Protection Association NFPA 1710 guideline which requires that fire apparatus and four firefighters arrive on-scene within four minutes.

“Our needs have evolved, and this new fire hall will provide our firefighters with the modern amenities and advanced equipment necessary to address the challenges of



today and tomorrow. It is designed to enhance our response times, reduce risks, and ensure the safety of our firefighters,” said Chief Ed Thiessen, Director of Fire Service. Read the full news

Howard Bouffard Secondary Plan Update

The Howard Bouffard Secondary Plan Project is being undertaken by the Town of LaSalle to establish a land use plan for the Howard Bouffard Planning Districts - prepared as an amendment to the approved Official Plan. In September, the Town asked residents

to review options, and get involved by sharing ideas and opinions on PlaceSpeak, a community engagement website. The site is currently closed, but a Public Open House (in-person and on PlaceSpeak) will be held in early 2024 to receive comments and feedback

on the Emerging Preferred Plan.

The plan will be re-evaluated following the comments received and revised if deemed appropriate by the consultant team and municipality.
