



Notice to Residents

The Town of LaSalle has contracted Mill-Am Paving to undertake road work on Matchette Road, from Reaume to Laurier. The work includes; full depth milling & replacing base/surface asphalt between Bouffard and Laurier, and adjusting manholes between Reaume & Laurier.

The adjustment of manholes will begin the week of Tuesday May 23rd, with the milling & paving to begin the following week. During the milling and paving operation we ask that all vehicles be removed from the road to limit disruption as much as possible. The milling and paving operation will take approximately 2 days to complete. Milling and placement of base asphalt one day and placement of surface asphalt the next. **“No Parking” signs will be posted the night before the mill and pave operation begins.** Please remove your vehicles from the road by 7:00 am the following morning so that work can start.

Please keep in mind that construction zones are hazardous areas. Use caution while driving and/or walking on the road during this period. The road will be open to through traffic during paving operations, there will be traffic control persons present, please watch for their direction. You will have access to your driveway during this work except during the brief period of time that work is taking place directly in front of your driveway.

Immediately prior to paving, a liquid tar product will be applied to the milled surface. Avoid all contact with this product as it is very hard to remove from vehicles and driveway surfaces. Traffic controllers will not direct you to drive onto these areas, so please follow their direction.
