The Town of LaSalle has retained Dillon Consulting Limited to undertake a study to revise and update the stormwater management trunk infrastructure plans for the Bouffard and Howard Planning Districts.

The purpose of the study is to review the challenges with the existing approved stormwater management plans and to identify alternative solutions to remove existing barriers and to reduce costs for development. The findings of the study will be used to update the Functional Design Study, which will review the infrastructure needs in the area including transportation, water, wastewater and which will be completed following the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process.

Based on input received during the course of this study, alternative solutions to the stormwater management servicing strategy have been developed in an effort to address the existing barriers to development.
