### COVID-19 Enforcement

On November 30, Windsor-Essex moves into the Red-Control level under the Keeping Ontario Safe & Open Framework. Since March, we have been asked to follow the advice of our public health officials. With the second wave of

the COVID-19 pandemic hitting our area, now is the time to enforce the public health orders.

The LaSalle Police Service will investigate violations of legislation related to COVID-19 enacted by Federal, Provincial or local governments or orders made by the Windsor Essex County Health Unit. If sufficient grounds exist, LaSalle Police will pursue charges, all of which carry a significant penalty.

Please follow the advice of our public health officials to keep everyone safe:

- stay home if you are sick,
- wash your hands often,
- limit your number of contacts,
- wear a face covering in public buildings, and
- limit personal indoor and outdoor gatherings.

It has been said many times, but this is an unprecedented time. We are all in this together. Please be kind to each other.
