The Town of LaSalle is home to several marinas and canals. Most are privately owned, and the owners have the legal right to restrict access to the property and their canals (including Town owned property). If you don't

have permission to be there, please don't enter the property. Remember, it is a good idea not to venture out on the ice when you are alone. Always tell someone where you are going before heading out.

With the retirement of LaSalle Police Chief John Leontowicz today, the Police Services Board has appointed Staff Sergeant Duncan Davies as Acting Chief. The new appointment comes into effect on January 30<sup>th</sup>.
