New Pedestrian Crossing Signal

A pedestrian crossing signal was installed at Malden Road and Reaume Road. This is an interim solution until the Malden Road improvements are done, which includes the reconstruction of the intersection.

Drivers: please be aware and if the lights on the poles are flashing, you must stop and allow the pedestrian to cross the full width of the road before proceeding.

Pedestrians: press the button to cross Malden Road. Proceed with caution and make sure that traffic has stopped in both directions before walking onto the road.
