



TRUCK OR TREAT EVENT

Truck or Treat Event Rules and Guidelines

LaSalle's Sparky's Toy Drive

Please note that the LaSalle Fire Service is hosting Sparky's Toy Drive. All participants are invited to bring in a new, unwrapped toy as a donation. All donations are greatly appreciated.



Upon Arrival:

- Please arrive 10 minutes prior to your confirmed registration time. Groups must remain in their vehicle until they are called by event staff to proceed to the entrance. Do not approach the entrance until you have been called. Screening questions will be asked over the phone prior to entry.
- Please park in a designated parking lot at the Vollmer Culture and Recreation Complex. Additional overflow parking lots are also available near the soccer fields and ball diamonds.
- One group must not exceed the 6 person limit. This limit is inclusive of infants and children. If groups exceed the 6 person limit, additional individuals will not be permitted entry.

Late Arrival:

- Late arrivals will not be permitted into the event. Please arrive in the parking lot prior to your registered start time.

Entrance:

- Once you have been called by our staff, please proceed to the marked entrance of the event to be checked-in. Costumes are welcome, but proper face coverings are required. Visit the WECHU website to view what constitutes a proper face covering.

- Pets, with the exception of service animals, will not be permitted entry.
- Participants will be required to answer screening questions on the phone before entry. Individuals will not be permitted into the event if they:
 - Are exhibiting any symptoms of Covid-19
 - Have been in contact with someone with Covid-19 in the past 14 days
 - Have returned from travel or been in contact with someone who has travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days (United States essential workers are exempt).

Physical Distancing:

- During the registration process, families are assigned a start time. Start times will be staggered, five minutes apart. This will ensure that there is a clear path of movement ahead at each station before proceeding. All foot traffic will proceed in one direction. Trucks and treat stations will be generously spaced apart. Markers will be set up to encourage physical distancing.
- Families will not be permitted to socialize or gather with those outside their registered group. One group cannot exceed 6 persons, including infants and children.

Hand Sanitizing:

- Guests will be required to sanitize at the entrance and exit of the event.

Face Coverings:

- Will be required for all participants over the age of 2.

Weather:

- This event will be held rain or shine. In the event of a serious weather event, communication will be posted by the Town of LaSalle on social media and email communications will be attempted.

Treats:

- A special bag will be provided to each individual upon entry. There will be no need for individuals to bring their own candy bag. Participants will be asked to pick up and take the first treat they touch (pre-packaged treats) at each station. Please note that there will be no cash sales at the event.

Touch surfaces:

- Staff will be continuously replenishing treats and sanitizing treat tables as guests move through each station. Please be courteous and touch only one treat. Parents must be responsible for monitoring children.

Trucks/Vehicles:

- Trucks on site are for looking only. Participants will not be permitted to climb, enter, jump or touch any vehicles on site. Those in contravention of the rules may be asked to leave.

Exit:

- Individuals will be asked to sanitize their hands on the way out and leave without delay upon the completion of the tour.

Duration:

- Groups should be able to complete the walkthrough of the event within 30 minutes.
