## Stormwater Master Plan Public Information Centre

The Town of LaSalle is working with Stantec Consulting Ltd. to prepare a Stormwater Master Plan (SWMP). This project will review the drainage system with a direct connection/discharge point into the Detroit River. An associated Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study is part of the process.

A Public Information Centre (PIC 1) is now being held virtually. A video, maps and other project information are available for viewing and comments. This information includes an introduction of the project, an overview of the identified problems and opportunities, and an overview of the existing conditions in the Study Area. Comments on PIC 1 materials are being accepted until August 9.

The Town will be using PlaceSpeak to share information about the SWMP project. The Town encourages the community to get involved and review the project resources on PlaceSpeak. To participate, the participant will need to create a PlaceSpeak account. This account only needs to be created once, and then the participant will have access to other Town of LaSalle consultation projects, as well as any other projects that are posted to PlaceSpeak. The participant's address is never displayed to other users or the administrators of the consultation. Addresses are collected to allow the administrators to know where respondents live. The main objective of the SWMP is to identify opportunities for potential infrastructure enhancements and improvements to protect public and private property from the effects of stormwater flooding while preserving the natural environment.

The project will be undertaken in three Stages, with each Stage covering a different stormwater catchment area within the Town. Maps are available on the website providing more details on the stages. Environmental and engineering investigations will be part of the overall project. At the conclusion of the study, a SWMP Study Report will be prepared for each stage to summarize the findings and recommendations while documenting the Class EA process. The three SWMP Study Reports will be made available for public review at the end of the study.
