Malden Road EA Addendum Approaching Finalization

The Town of LaSalle hosted a consultation session from December 2020 to February 2021 about the Malden Road Transportation, Public Safety and Urban Design Improvements. Since then, the consultation team has reviewed all of the feedback, and has been working on the finalizing of the Malden Road EA Addendum documents.

LaSalle Town Council will be receiving a report from administration, summarizing the finalized documents, at the September 28, 2021 Regular Meeting of Council. The Council agenda and report will be available to the public in the afternoon on September 17, 2021 on the Town [website](#).

Important information about the status of the Malden Road EA Addendum will be discussed at this Council meeting. We encourage residents to get involved and take a look at the report. Anyone wishing to speak about the report at the September 28 Council meeting must register with the Council Services Department by noon on Friday, September 24. Council meetings are streamed on the Town's [YouTube channel](#).

The Town of LaSalle is working with Stantec Consulting Ltd. to complete a 10-year review of the 2009 Schedule C Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) for Malden Road/County Road 3. Based on the review of information completed to date, the recommendations address the identified problems and opportunities along the corridor. The recommended solution includes:

- Widen Malden Road between Cahill Drain and Meagan Drive to three lanes (includes one lane in each direction and two-way left turn lane)
- Signalize the Reaume Road intersection
- Re-align and signalize Bouffard Road
- Install new sidewalks and buffered bike lanes on both sides of Malden Road
- Implement pedestrian crosswalk and multi-use trails near the Cahill Drain
- No changes are being recommended for the section of Malden Road between Normandy and the city limits (the work associated with this part of the 2009 EA has already been constructed)

The work done to date can be reviewed by visiting the Malden Road EA Addendum on the Town's website. Once Council approves the final EA Addendum document, it will be posted to the website for another public consultation period.
