LaSalle Garbage Collection

- You will receive WEEKLY garbage collection on Tuesday or Friday (NOT both). Please check the list below to identify which day your street will receive garbage collection. Your garbage day will be identified by a garbage can icon.
- Place GARBAGE out for collection. the night before your scheduled collection day.
- Fri. Tues
- Large Items & Furniture: Will be picked up on your regularly scheduled garbage day (with the exception of white goods). Items such as box springs, mattresses, couches, chairs, and similar materials can be put out on any regular garbage day. Please call GFL Environmental Inc. at 519-944-8009 to advise if you have a large item for pick up.
- If you have questions regarding your garbage collection (i.e. - what is acceptable) please call GFL Environmental Inc. at 519-944-8009.
- **Unacceptable Garbage Containers:** Do not place garbage out in containers that are: Oversized & Overweight: Containers cannot weigh (over 20 kg / 45 lbs.) Plastic Shopping Bags: Do NOT place them at the curb. Cardboard Boxes: Recycle or use for Yard Waste!

NON-COLLECTABLE Waste: Waste that is deemed non-collectable includes: Ammunition, animal carcasses, animal waste, appliances, automotive parts, bricks, combustibles, chemical waste, computer equipment, concrete, construction and demolition waste, explosives, industrial waste, liquid waste, medical waste, metal items, pallets, paint products, renovation debris, syringes, televisions, and tires. These items are not garbage and will NOT be collected – check index for Public Drop Off information.

Yard Waste Collection

Basic Collection Requirements:

- Yard Waste collection is EVERY OTHER WEEK beginning in April and ending in October (on Saturdays for the entire Town of LaSalle). Please refer to calendar for pick-up dates.
- Look for the Paper Yard Waste Bag (symbol).
 It will indicate your Yard Waste Collection Day.



Look for the Leaf (symbol) in November. It will indicate your Leaf Collection Day.

The only **ACCEPTABLE CONTAINERS** for Yard Waste are:

- Paper Yard Waste Bags
- Cardboard Boxes
- Garbage Cans / Pails



No Plastic Bags for Yard Waste!

Yard Waste Preparation:

- Yard Waste is defined as grass, leaves, garden trimmings, brush and branches.
- Tree & Hedge Trimmings: Tied in bundles (max.length 4ft./

Tied in bundles (max.length 4ft./ max.diameter 2 ft.)



Garden Waste:

Flowers, vegetables, pumpkins, plants, and fruit should be put in cardboard boxes, paper yard waste bags, or garbage pails/cans.

Leaves:

Leaves will be collected during the month of November and December. Do NOT put yard waste in with your leaves, or they will NOT be collected.

Christmas Trees:

Remove ornaments, bags and stands. Recycle your Christmas Tree at one of the designated depots (see list below):

- River Canard Park (Malden Rd.)
- LaSalle Landing / Gil Maure Park (Front Rd.)
- Optimist Park (Victory St.)
- Heritage Park (Heritage Dr.)
- Vince Marcotte Park (LaSalle St. and Normandy Rd.)
- Public Works Building (Judy Recker Dr.)



Recycling Collection (only)





All properties WEST of Malden Rd. (includes the WEST side of Malden Rd.)

ZONE 2 every other Monday All properties EAST of Malden Rd. (includes the EAST side of Malden Rd.)

Recycling Days:

LaSalle recycling collection is divided into zones (see map above).

Zone 1: Recycling collection is every other Tuesday.

Zone 2: Recycling collection is every other Monday.



Grass Clippings

Try grasscycling! Leave them on your lawn.

If you must place grass clippings out, put them in garbage pails. Do NOT use plastic bags.

Grass clippings will be collected until the last Yard Waste collection day in November.

Grass clippings placed out for regular garbage collection will NOT be picked up.

Leaf Collection

Leaves will be collected in November and December. Please see the calendar, as indicated by the leaf symbol. The entire Town of LaSalle will be picked up on these dates. Leaves must be placed out for collection in approved containers.

Leaves will NOT be collected in plastic bags. Bags containing garbage or yard waste will NOT be picked up.

Place your leaves out for collection on the night before your scheduled leaf collection days.

THE GREEN BINS ARE COMING!

The EWSWA is rolling out the new Green Bin collection program to keep food waste and organics out of the Essex-Windsor Regional Landfill. Bin delivery to all single-family households in Phase1 runs from July to October. Over 150,000 homes will receive Green Bins, so please be patient yours will be delivered before the October 21st program launch.



What To Expect

- 🗤 Delivery schedules can be found on the Recycle Coach app, the EWSWA website (www.ewswa.org) and social media.
- Your 120L EWSWA Green Bin has a gravity lock and comes with a Starter Kit that includes a kitchen catcher, sample compostable

bag, and information on using the Green Bin.

₩ Collection starts in October, so please be sure to store your Green Bin safely until then.

Winter Roads Maintenance

During the winter months, main roads are cleared and salted first, followed by residential and secondary roads. Be sure to maintain a safe distance from snowplows and avoid pushing driveway snow back onto the road.

During winter snowfall, property owners are encouraged to:

- · Park vehicles in driveways, not on the road.
- Maintain clear catch basins for proper drainage.
- · Keep fire hydrants visible and snow-free.
- · Clear sidewalks adjoining your property.
- Place garbage and recycle bins in the driveway approach, not on snow banks or the road.

Residents should wait to clear their driveway approaches until the plows have cleared the curb lanes.





Natural Christmas Tree Drop-Off

LaSalle residents are reminded that natural Christmas trees will not be collected with regular garbage. Drop off natural Christmas trees to the designated areas at:

- River Canard Park (Malden Rd.)
- LaSalle Landing (Front Rd.)
- Optimist Park (Victory St.)
- Heritage Park (Heritage Dr.)
- Vince Marcotte Park (LaSalle St. and Normandy Rd.)
- Public Works Building (Judy Recker Cres.)

Trees will be picked up from these locations into February. These trees are chipped into mulch for town projects, and are also used on Fighting Island for natural regeneration.
