


# Mayor's Message <u>A Message from Mayor C</u>rystal Meloche

### **Matchett Road Bridge**

The Matchett Road Bridge over Turkey Creek project began this week. The project will repair the bridge and upgrade the sidewalk to a multi-use path, and it will be completed in two stages.

From now until early April, there will be narrow lanes and occasional lane closures, so please expect delays. During April and May, the bridge will be fully closed, meaning no vehicles or pedestrians will be able to cross.

## Winter Tips for LaSalle

- Remove vehicles/sports equipment from the road
- Clear catch basins of snow/ice
- Keep fire hydrants clear
- Keep municipal sidewalks next to your property clear
- Place garbage cans/recycle bins in the driveway, not on snow banks/road
