Seeking Experienced Police Constable

The mission of the LaSalle Police Service *to provide community leadership and service excellence*. In support of our mission the LaSalle Police Service is currently accepting applications for the position of:

Experienced Police Constable – Currently serving police constable in Ontario or elsewhere in Canada with at least one year of experience and completed probationary period.

The duties of a police officer Include:

- Preserving the peace
- Preventing crimes and other offences and providing assistance and encouragement to other persons in their prevention
- Assisting victims of crime
- Apprehending criminals and other offenders and others who may lawfully be taken into custody
- Laying charges and participating in prosecutions
- Executing warrants and performing related duties
- Performing the lawful duties that the Chief of Police assigns
- Completing required training
- Complying with the prescribed Code of Conduct, and
- Performing any other duties that are lawfully assigned

Applicants Must:

- Meet the minimum requirements of *the Community Safety and Policing Act, 2019*

- Be of good moral character
- Possess a valid driver's licence
- Possess valid CPR and First Aid certification
- Be physically and mentally fit
- Have a sound knowledge of the Town of LaSalle

Experienced Police Constable applicants shall provide the following information at the time of application:

1. Cover letter
2. Resume
3. A copy of the Basic Constable Training certificate from the Ontario Police College (or equivalent if outside Ontario)
4. Two most recent performance appraisals
5. Copy of formal education (college diploma/university degree)
6. A list of completed police related training/courses/designations (do not send copies of the certificates)

Note: As a condition of employment, an experienced police constable from outside the province of Ontario must write and successfully pass the Ontario Police College Equivalency Examination.
