 The Loop is unsupervised. Users assume full risks or injury. The Town does not accept responsibility for any related risks or injury. The User is responsible for ensuring they are fit to participate in physical activity.


 Children aged 10 and under must be supervised by a parent/guardian.


 The water operates on a timed cycle. To start the water, press the red button located on the post.


 Water shoes or sandals are strongly recommended.


 Appropriate attire must be worn at all times.


 Pets must be on leash at all times.

 In the event of an emergency call 9-1-1.

 No horseplay or games such as tag or races. Users are required to always conduct themselves properly.

 Recreational water is not intended for consumption. Avoid swallowing water.

 No food, beverages, glass containers, or breakable objects allowed.

 No skateboards, roller blades, bicycles, or scooters allowed.
