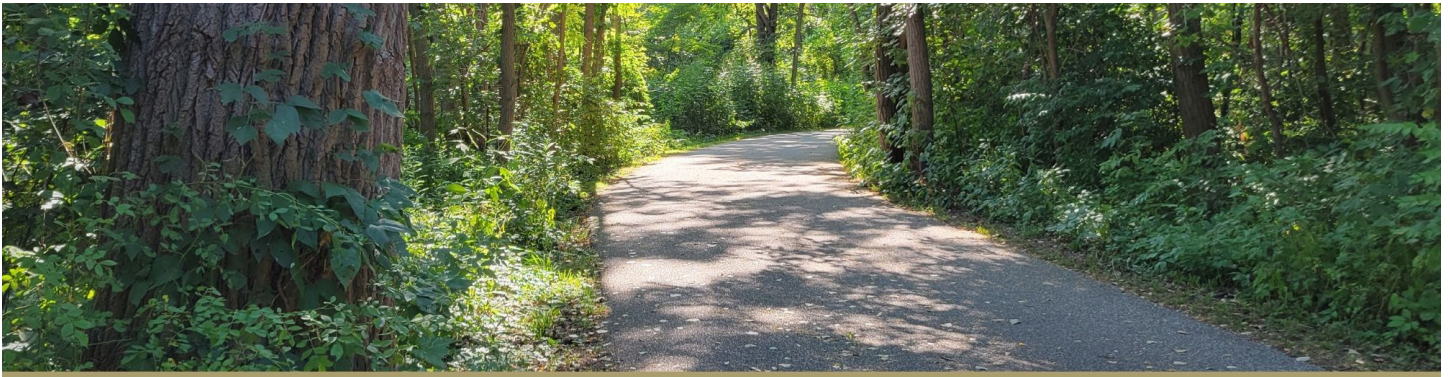




Mayer's Message

A Message from Mayor Crystal Meloche

Hello residents of LaSalle,

National Day for Truth and Reconciliation is on Tuesday, September 30. This day is intended for all Canadians to have meaningful conversations about the effects of Residential Schools and to uphold our commitment to reconciliation. The Indian Residential School System operated across Canada for over 100 years, with the last school closing in the 1990's. Indian Residential Schools were created to separate indigenous children from their families and communities, and to systematically strip away their traditions, culture practices, and languages. Together, we honour the survivors of Residential Schools and acknowledge the pain that they and their families have carried for generations. We must come together to build a future based on relationships, and mutual respect.

September 30 is also recognized as Orange Shirt Day, inspired by the story of Residential School survivor, Phyllis Webstad.

In recognition of National Day of Truth and Reconciliation, LaSalle Municipal Offices will be closed. The Vollmer Centre will remain open.
