

Construction Under Way at LaSalle Landing

Construction of an ice skate trail and water feature is under way at LaSalle Landing on Front Road. LaSalle Council awarded the project to Valente Contracting Inc. in the amount of \$8.8 M at the February 27, 2024 Regular Meeting. The project includes an ice skate trail and water feature, ice plant mechanical equipment building, and a parking lot expansion. The ice skate trail is scheduled to be open in late 2024 and is estimated to be usable between December and February annually.

When the ice is not installed, the concrete surface can be used as a multipurpose trail. The trail is estimated to be approximately 250m in length and could be used for recreational walking, jogging, and







rollerblading and will be accessible for wheelchair use.

"This will be a year round facility for our residents to enjoy. It's going to transform an area of our Town that we haven't focused on in a very long time," says Mayor Crystal Meloche.

Adding to the uniqueness of the LaSalle Landing project, a lit "LaSalle" sign will be installed facing Front Road, near the ice skate trail and water feature. The letters will spell out LaSalle and will be about 2.4 m (8') tall.

Also part of the project is a water feature with ground-orientated water jets for summertime activities, benches to relax, and a garden area. The Rotary Club of

LaSalle-Centennial has pledged \$132,000 in support of the project, and this will be used to enhance the design of the features. The water feature is scheduled to open in the spring of 2025. The Rotary Club recently launched a fundraising campaign to support their initiative.

Second Fire Station Under Construction

Construction is under way for the Town's future second fire station, located at 2160 Front Road. The tender was awarded to Gulf Developments with a bid of \$9 M. It is expected that the second fire station will be open for use in early 2025.

"With the Town's growth, our needs have evolved, and this new fire hall will provide our firefighters with the modern amenities and advanced

equipment necessary to address the challenges of Normandy St., today and tomorrow. It is designed to enhance our response times, reduce risks, and ensure the safety of our firefighters," said Chief Ed Thiessen, Director of Fire Service.

The Three Fire Station Operating Model and Financial Plan was approved by LaSalle Council in March 2022. This model includes the existing headquarters

station on a west station at 2160 Front Road, and an east station on Laurier

Parkway in the area of Disputed Road.

The three fire station model is based on moving towards staffing each location with full-time firefiahters. The third station is scheduled to be built in 2031 and can be

adjusted if needed based on future growth in La-Salle.


