Pursuant to *Ontario Regulation 392/23 Adequate and Effective Policing (General) - Emergency Response*, it is the policy of the LaSalle Police Services Board (the Board) with respect to the services of a Hostage Rescue Team that:

- a) Hostage Rescue Team support services are available 24 hours a day and within a reasonable response time through the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) Framework Agreement; and
- b) The Chief of Police, in consultation with the OPP will:
  - I. Establish and maintain written procedures that set out the circumstances in which the service will be deployed, including the steps for obtaining the service and the reporting relationships; and
  - II. Ensure that the Police Service's major incident commanders and crisis negotiators train with the other police service's hostage rescue team, when applicable.
