Hello residents of LaSalle,

We had an exciting announcement on Tuesday, September 9. Minister of Infrastructure, Kinga Surma, and Essex MPP, Anthony Leardi, announced the Ontario government is investing \$22.4M in Town of LaSalle stormwater infrastructure to allow the long term development of approximately 10,000 new homes in the Howard Bouffard area.

This is the largest grant we have received in the Town's history, and it's a huge step forward as we continue to grow. It means we'll have the right infrastructure in place to support our new residents, but even more importantly—our existing residents, while helping us meet provincial housing goals in a responsible and sustainable way. This will help us build a stronger, more vibrant LaSalle for generations to come.

On September 5 and 6, we hosted LaSalle's Last Call Before Fall at

the Event Centre at LaSalle
Landing, and once again it was a
huge success. Saturday was sold
out, and there was such great
energy all weekend. I want to
thank our staff, who always put it
a ton of hard work for these
events. We also thank our
vendors, and the volunteers who
make these events possible.
