



## **Municipal Election Frequently Asked Questions**

### **What happens after I register to vote?**

Eligible electors will receive a Voter Information Letter (VIL) in the mail. This letter includes the PIN number that will be used to log into the voting system.

### **How and where do I vote?**

The Town of LaSalle 2026 Municipal Election will be held electronically via internet. You can vote from virtually anywhere, 24 hours a day during the voting period.

Paper ballots will not be used as a method of voting.

### **When can I vote?**

Votes can be cast using any computer or wireless device, 24 hours a day from virtually anywhere beginning Friday October 16<sup>th</sup>, 2026 at 10:00am through to Monday October 26<sup>th</sup> until 8:00pm.

### **What if I don't have access to the internet or need help with the voting process?**

If you require internet access and/or a device to vote on, the Town of LaSalle will hold Voter Help Centres. Times and dates will be posted on the [Town of LaSalle Election webpage](#).

### **Can I Verify my Vote?**

**Verify App LaSalle** allows voters to validate if their vote intentions were correctly stored in the digital ballot box.

Once logged in the app, the voter can scan the QR code they received right after voting, which is used locally by the app to decrypt and display the content of the vote without compromising voter's privacy.

In the event that the vote cast does not correspond to the voter's intent, the mobile application will inform the voter on how to proceed.

The Verify App will be made available to download on the Google Play and Apple Store.

### **Are there voting regulations?**

Whether you cast your ballot online or in person, the integrity of the electoral process and secrecy of your vote is very important. The Municipal Elections Act states that no person shall:

- Vote without being qualified to do so,
- Vote more than once in the Town of LaSalle,
- Interfere with a voter who is marking a ballot,
- Obtain or attempt to obtain information about how an elector has or will vote

### **Can I take a picture of or with my ballot?**

Taking a picture of a completed ballot—yours or anyone else's—is a violation of the Municipal Elections Act because it violates the secrecy of the vote. It is also a violation of the Act to publish a photo of a completed ballot on your social media channels or elsewhere.

### **How is voter information kept secure and private?**

The Town of LaSalle takes precautions to ensure that the personal information of voters is kept secure and is used for authorized purposes only. Voter information collected by the Town of LaSalle can only be used for election purposes, in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Elections Act.

### **What are the penalties for voter fraud?**

Each eligible voter can only vote once in the Town of LaSalle 2026 Municipal Election, regardless of how many properties they own – it's the law. If convicted of voter fraud, you may face:

- A fine of up to \$25,000
- Jail time for up to 6 months
