Front Road Storm Sewer Reconstruction Work Begins

The project is set to begin the week of July 14, starting with work on Adams Lane. Major traffic delays are expected to begin closer to August as the project moves forward. The reconstruction area includes Front Road from Reaume Road to Boismier Avenue. Lane restrictions will be in place into December - and open for winter season. Lane restrictions will occur again in early 2026. Project expected to wrap up by spring 2026. We encourage drivers to begin planning alternate routes or leave extra travel time.
