Front Road Storm Sewer Reconstruction

The major Front Road Storm Sewer reconstruction project is scheduled to begin on Monday, March 9. The reconstruction area includes the section of Front Road from Boismier Avenue to Reaume Road. This work will include lane restrictions along Front Road. Intersection closures will occur at Maple Ave, Kenwood Ave, Delaware Ave, Sacred Heart Dr, and Boismier Ave. Major traffic delays are expected.

Consider alternate routes prior to leaving for your destination, as well as anticipating extra travel time. Businesses in these areas will remain open, and I encourage residents to continue supporting them throughout the project period. Detour signs will be posted to help guide traffic.
