Senior Active Living Centre Grant

On Friday, January 24 we welcomed MPP Anthony Leardi to the Vollmer Centre for a special announcement. We were successful in a grant application for a Senior Active Living Centre Grant of \$55,000 on behalf of Minister Cho and the Ministry of Seniors and Accessibility.

This improved accessibility will enable us to expand activities for seniors in LaSalle across three different locations; the LaSalle Civic Centre, the Vollmer Complex, and the Event Centre at LaSalle Landing. This aligns with our goal to provide more opportunities for seniors to stay connected and enhance their overall wellbeing.
