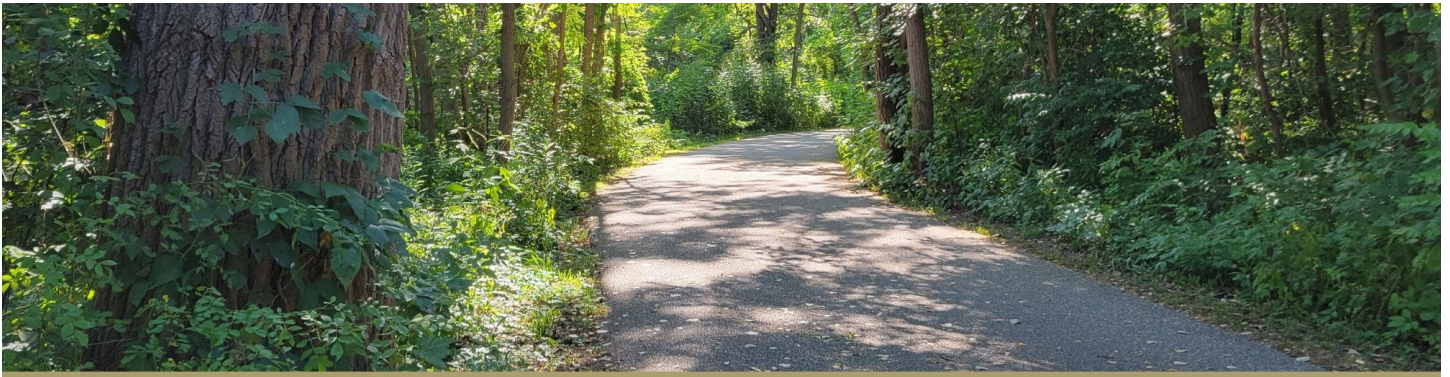




Mayor's Message

Hello residents of LaSalle,

World Mental Health Day is on Friday, October 10.
